You will need to build a platform so that you can start to share your product. This could be YouTube, it could be a blog or whatever other market interests you. You don't have to reach everyone.

That's a waste of effort. Instead, focus on reaching the audience that would be interested in what you have to offer.

Determine which products are going to serve you best and then offer your audience value. In fact, offering them something of value for free helps to establish trust and interest so that they are far more likely to buy whatever else it is you have to offer.

They now know you have expertise in your niche and something that's worth listening to so they are ready to pay.

As your passive income builds and you become comfortable in your business, make sure that the profit never becomes your main motivation, because when it does you set yourself up for failure.

You don't get paid unless you win so you will need to enter as many contests as you can find in your niche. Success is often minimal, but it only takes one big win and you'll be very happy.

#5 Flip Domain Names – Domain names are as valuable as real estate. Well, actually, they are online real estate. Some people have figured out a way to make a very nice income buying and selling domain names.

Use Google Adwords to find trending keywords and then use that information to choose domains to flip. Short, straightforward domains are pretty much all

bought, so you will likely have to settle for acronyms, initials, the use of dashes, etc. Be creative when you are trying to buy domain names.

Even if the main keyword isn't available you can work off of that keyword and incorporate it with other words.

Making a living quickly and easy by making the right choices. With so many opportunities online it can be difficult to determine what's the right way. Part of it depends on how much time you have available to you and where your interests lie. One thing is for certain, there are tons of legitimate ways to make money online, so why not start today?

Chapter 3: Make Money from Writing Online

A quick search and you will discover there are many ways for you to make a living online. If you like to write there is a complete world that opens up for you.

There is such a demand for writing, editing and proofreading that if you are at all any good you should not have any trouble finding projects.

There are many places to find writing assignments online. Sites like Guru.com, Elance.com, oDesk.com demandstudios.com and associatedcontent.com are all options.

The first three, Guru, Elance and oDesk are setup in a manner where you bid on writing projects that are posted by clients with a need.

Your fees vary as do the commissions, so compare and choose which setup seems to be right for you. Elance has the lowest monthly fee, which is rather appealing and oDesk seems to be the most difficult to work on.

Associated Content and Demand Studios offer a different way of writing. They hire experienced freelance writers and editors. Demand Studios pays between \$15 to \$100 per assignment.

An added bonus is that you could be eligible for health insurance if you meet activity requirements and tenure. Associate Content offers three ways for you to make money.

You can get paid upfront anywhere from \$2 to \$15 per article, you can earn performance payments of \$1.50/1000 page views or you can be assigned articles and get paid from \$10 to \$100 per article.

At Associated Content there are three ways to earn money: Upfront payments for content you write (\$2 to \$15 per article), assigned articles (\$10 to \$100 per

article) and performance payments (\$1.50 for every 1,000 page views of your article if it's posted online).

Editing jobs and proofreading jobs are also readily available, especially on Elance and Guru.

Again, you bid and then wait for the vendor to make their decision and pick a provider.

You might consider writing an e-book and marketing it through one of the many self publishers, which includes Amazon, which is an excellent way to make a steady stream of passive income.

Don't just write any e-book. Seek out a niche that you have something to share and make sure that the market isn't already saturated. Selling e-books can make you a solid income when done right.

You might also decide to launch a blog in a niche you are interested in, then as your readership grows, you can start to post ads or affiliate promos to make money.

AdSense allows you to make a little bit of money every time someone clicks an ad. Amazon offers an affiliate program where you earn a commission if a purchase is made through your link.

Writing offers an opportunity to easily make a full time income.

So if you love to write, here's your opportunity.

They will then share them and you'll get a percentage of their ad revenue as well as a fee each time your video is downloaded.

Create Backgrounds for MySpace

There's a market for backgrounds for MySpace. They are not hard to create but most people won't take the time. This is an opportunity for you to offer a service where you create custom MySpace pages for a fee.

Create YouTube Videos

YouTube is useful in getting known on the web. In fact, it can create instant stardom quite easily. YouTube and other sites like make it easy for you to have an opportunity to be discovered.

If you are a talented singer a record label might see you. But that's just one way to make money on YouTube. You can create product review videos linked to an affiliate program and generate a commission.

You can also create courses, offering the first video free and then pay as you use.

Design Custom T-Shirts and Other Cool Things

If you are always coming up with catchy phrases, there's a market waiting for you. You can make a good income designing and selling t-shirts and other cool things on sites like CafePress.

They don't have to buy anything or stay for any period of time, so it's easy revenue when you have adequate traffic flow.

If you have really strong content, consider cost per acquisition advertising. With cost per acquisition advertising you make a good commission, that will either be a fixed rate or it will be an agreed upon commission that you will be paid each time someone makes a purchase on your site for that affiliate company.

You can see how making money online does not have to be complicated, especially when you are using online marketing opportunities.

Customers ask a question and an expert replies with an answer. ChaCha is another site that you can provide advice, although the pay ranges from 1 cent – 20 cents so you need to build a real following in order to do well.

Pitch Products

Pitching products of others online is a great paying gig. One way to do this is as an affiliate at one of the huge sites like Amazon.com where you can earn commissions that are as high as 25%.

When someone buys a product that you are pitching you will earn a commission. You can choose from the millions of products on the site and that includes computers and gift cards.

ClickBank is another site where you can make decent money. Their commission is as high as 75% and there are over 50,000 products you can choose from. There is no cost to signup.

However, ClickBank products are of a poorer quality caliber than those offered on Amazon, so just be aware of this.

Their prices can often be much cheaper too, and so that can make it easier to pitch and sell than others. If you are concerned, you can always buy the product yourself and determine if you feel you want to market it.

Perform a Microgig

You can provide services online at task marketplaces like Zaarly.com or Fiverr.com where workers complete tasks starting as little as \$5 per job. You can also head to MTurk.com where there are more than 200,000 tasks listed to make money online with various work requirements and pay.

Once you complete a task, your pay goes into your Amazon payment account. Your skills can be used for almost anything. You will be competing against those in developing nations, so you have to be willing to work for pennies. There is still money to be made as long as you carefully assess the task before taking it.

Chapter 11: 10 Step Process to Earn from Flipping Websites

There are so many scams online it is difficult to figure out which ones are real and how you really can make some money online.

There's no question you can make an above average income online – even a six figure income; however, with many you need to be very patient.

There is one opportunity that offers you a solid income and doesn't take time to build – flipping websites. This is an opportunity to create a 6 figure income for yourself.

7. The money is going to start to flow into your PayPal account. Keep promoting your site and focusing on making as much money as you can. Keep track of every penny it makes.

8. After 6 months you should calculate how much income you have generated and then double it to get the revenue for the year. Now's the time to sell.

9. Set your price. Generally a site sells for 2 to 5 times more than the income it earns yearly. So if you made \$20,000 in that 6 months you could sell your site for \$40,000 to \$100,000. The larger companies are more likely to pay higher prices than a smaller company.

10. Congratulations, you've built your first website and flipped it. Now it's time to do it again.

Website flipping is a bit like real estate. In fact, it's online website real estate rather than house real estate. You build, design, create something that's attractive and desirable to others and then you sell it. What an easy way to make a comfortable living.

Software Review

Some websites, such as SoftwareJudge, pay users for using and then reviewing the software they have available in their collection. Writing detailed reviews that are honest will increase your earnings significantly.

Amazon Mechanical Turk

This is one of the largest micro freelancing websites out there with millions of people around the world earning extra money by doing simple tasks that machines or computers cannot do.

This could be as simple as differentiating text and pictures, transcribing an audio file, or rewriting a sentence. While tasks don't often pay a lot, it's a good option to earn some extra money whenever you have a few extra hours.

#3 Audio Products

It's fairly easy to create an audio using a service like Audioacrobat or some other similar service. It allows you to earn two income streams off of one product.

#4 Affiliate Advertising

Affiliate advertising can be a profitable form of online income if you have a blog already and now you want to start making money off of it.

Some of the easiest ways to start generating affiliate advertising income is through sites like Google, Commission Junction or Clickbank.

Affiliate advertising is performance based so you don't earn any money until someone actually clicks on the link. You aren't likely to get rich on this, at least early on, but it can provide another income flow option.

Here are 4 ways you can make a legitimate income online. There are others. Just avoid the sounds too good to be true offers, because they are.

#1 Design websites and graphics

One of the best places to find work online if you are a computer programmer or designer is Elance.com. Companies will post the job they need done and the freelance will bid on it. The company makes their decision based on bid price and portfolio. Elance takes 4% to 6% commission.

#2 Tutor kids

If you have your college degree you could consider tutoring kids in math, English, social studies or science.

Work as an independent contractor and earn \$10 to \$15 per hour depending on hours worked and subject. Active tutors easily earn from \$800 to \$1600 a month. Tutor.com is a good site to explore if this kind of work interests you.

#3 Provide customer service

Many retailers are now outsourcing their customer service operations to companies like Alpine Access and Working Solutions who then contract to home based workers. If you think customer service can't be fun, it's probably not right for you.

The best customer service reps love to help their customers and find it fun and rewarding. These reps usually work 20 to 40 hours per week. The hourly rate is \$9 but agents earn as much as \$13 with incentives and special projects can pay as much as \$30/hour.

LiveOps runs a similar kind of company, but its service reps are all independent contractors and they generally invoice for \$10 to \$15 an hour depending on the call type. With LiveOps you decide how many hours to work.

#4 Sell your crafts

Do you make jewelry? Paint? Knit? If so, there are all kinds of great ways for you to sell your handmade goods.

Etsy is one of the most well known sites. You have your own online store where you can showcase the items you have created. It costs nothing to become a seller on Etsy, but it will cost you 20 cents to list an item for 4 months.

When it sells you pay 3.5% commission to Etsy. It is a reasonable listing fee so vendors can afford to list their items. There are other sites like Jewelry Wonder and ArtFire that are worth looking at.

Ejury.com is another site that pays you for being part of a mock jury online. You are paid \$5 to \$10 for every verdict. The attorney prepares his/her case submission.

This is made up of facts from each party's perspective. EJury converts the attorney's submission into an online format and then posts it to a secure ewebsite location where only Ejurors have access.

They review the facts of the case, provide answers to the questions, hit the 'submit verdict' button when done and get paid.

These methods will make you some extra spending money, but they won't make you rich. However, not everyone that wants to make money online is ready to quit their day job.

Don't be afraid to get creative. 28 year old Stefanie Strobel lives in Newport Beach, California and who offers to write people's messages in the beach sand, take a picture and email it to them.

He can do about 10 messages in an hour depending on how complex they are and he makes himself around \$300 a month.

#3 Offer advice

Do you know tons about herbal medicine, car repairs, pets, etc. Whatever you have some expertise in, you could turn it into a way to make money.

At JustAnswer you can get paid for your knowledge. It's a paid question and answer website with a growing field of experts. Customers register, ask their question and name the price they are willing to pay for an expert answer.

The average is between \$10 and \$40 dollars. The expert responds within the hour and when the customer accepts the answer you earn 25% to 50% of what customers pays. How much you earn depends on how many questions you answer. Experts are vetted to ensure the credentials they provide are accurate.

That's just 3 ways to earn money online, there are hundreds of other options. Find what fits you and go for it.
